The University of Maine at Augusta, University of Maine System, and several donor organizations offer a variety of scholarship opportunities to UMA students. All scholarships require a **minimum academic Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.0**, unless otherwise specified in the scholarship description. Completion of the application only certifies that you will be considered for the scholarship(s) you check off on the application. Be sure to read each scholarship description and the application instructions carefully before applying. Scholarship awards will depend on the amount of money available and the number of qualified recipients.

Please attach a résumé and cover-letter which contains a personal statement as to why you feel that you should be considered for a scholarship. **Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.** These scholarships are awarded in April or May for the upcoming academic year, (i.e. Fall and/or Spring semesters). **Students graduating in the fall semester of 2012, or summer 2012 session, are not eligible for these Scholarships.**

Scholarships that are based on financial eligibility require that the applicant submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the federal processor by February 15th to meet UMA's preferred filing date of March 1, 2012.

For an Augusta based Criminal Justice major with current or prior military experience that has attained at least 30 academic credits.

Financial eligibility, leadership, service to UMA and wider community.

Richard James Goggin Memorial Scholarship

Parents, classmates and friends of Richard Goggin established this award in his memory. He was killed in action in Vietnam during April of 1971.

General Edmund W. Hill Scholarship
Scholarship assistance for a worthy student. The fund was established in 1977 by a bequest from Mildred Hill, Widow of Edmund W. Hill.

Lloyd J. Jewett Scholarship
Academically talented student from the Kennebec Valley area, with special consideration given to part-time students. Students, faculty and community members created this scholarship in memory of UMA's first president.

Bennett D. Katz Scholarship
Financial eligibility and academic merit. The University established the Katz Scholarship in 1999.

Augusta Kiwanis Club Scholarship
Financial eligibility, merit, and service to the school or community of a non-traditional student residing in the Club's service area. The Club established this scholarship to assist students in obtaining the life-changing education they seek.
