

TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) receives funding through a federal grant competition. Funds are awarded to institutions of higher education to provide opportunities for academic development, assist students with basic college requirements, and to motivate students toward the successful completion of their postsecondary education. SSS projects may also provide grant aid to current participants who are receiving Federal Pell Grants. The program was launched in 1968, as Special Services for Disadvantaged Students (later known as Student Support Services), part of the Higher Education Act. The primary goal of SSS is to increase the college retention and graduation rates of its participants. Alumni of Student Support Services include Oprah Winfrey, Angela Bassett, Patrick Ewing, Viola Davis, and Franklin Chang-Diaz.

More than 1,000 colleges, universities, community colleges, and agencies now offer TRIO Programs in America, the Caribbean, and the Pacific Islands.

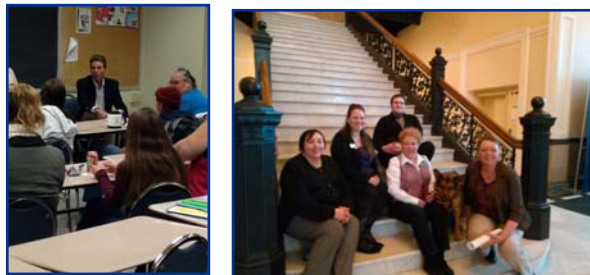

**To enroll in TRIO you must meet all of the following requirements:**

- Enroll in a four-year degree program at UMA
- Require academic support
- Be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States

**AND**

**You must meet at least one of the following:**

Be a first generation college student (neither parent/guardian has a Bachelor's degree)

**OR**

Meet Federal income guidelines for financial aid.

**OR**

Have a documented disability which impacts your learning process.
