

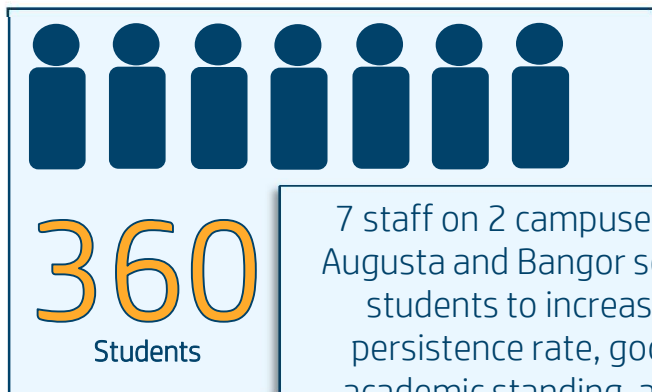

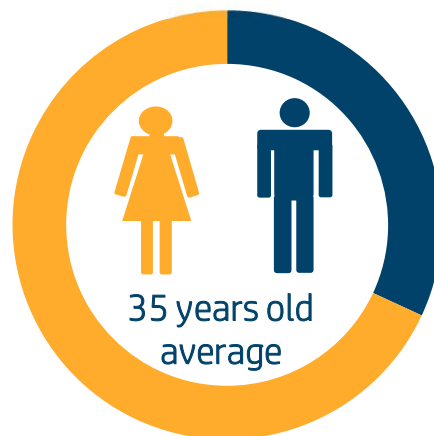
## TRIO Student Support Services

### 2015-2016 Annual Performance Report

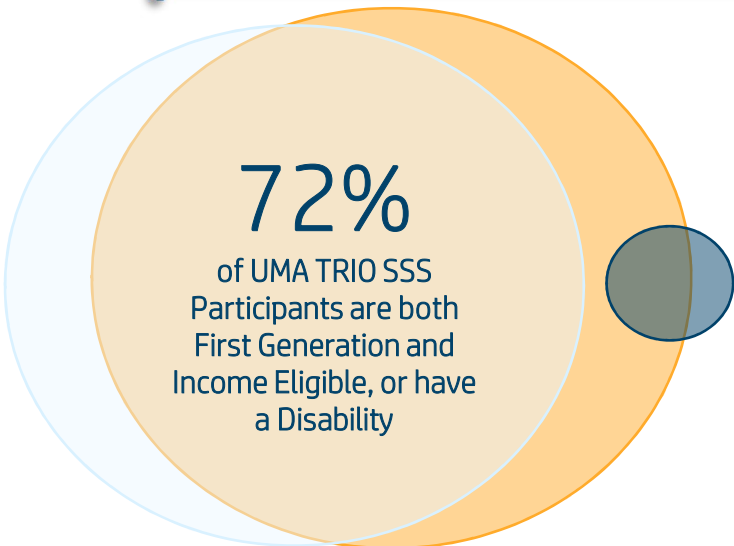
TRIO Student Support Services is funded by a Federal Title IV grant to provide amplified services to students who are First Generation college students, low income, and/or living with disabilities that impact their scholarship. UMA's grant is \$2.5M for 5 years [2015-2020] and operated on a '15-'16 budget of \$484,682.



7 staff on 2 campuses in Augusta and Bangor serve students to increase persistence rate, good academic standing, and graduation within 6 years



#### Who does UMA TRIO SSS Serve?



- First Generation 18%
- First Generation & Income Eligible 58%
- Income Eligible 10%
- Income Eligible & Differently Abled 9%
- Differently Abled 5%



The TRIO SSS team of 7 staff and 23 student peer coaches logged 4,491 hours and 12 minutes of contact with participants in non-cognitive skills-building and coaching in personal scholarship, financial literacy, and academic resiliency. 1,573 hours of that contact were made possible by \$14,157 in Federal work study monies.
