	Legal Guardianship: You are or were in legal guardianship as determined by a court in your state of legal residence prior to reaching the age of being an adult in your state.	Provide a copy of a court's decision documenting you are in legal guardianship from the state of your legal residence.
	Homeless Youth: You were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless or was self-supporting and at risk of being homeless.	Please submit a copy of the document from the director of a youth basic center/educational agency homeless liaison/shelter director stating your official unaccompanied homeless youth status.
