

URock Student Association Meeting Minutes – 04-03-19

Previous Events

Game Night (3/21): 10 people (in addition to the SA members who were there) showed up. Several people asked if we would be continuing to hold game nights, so word is starting to get around.

Date of Next SA Meeting (4/18): we agreed to have the next meeting on Thursday, 4/18 (same day as lasagna making) instead of Wednesday of that week. This will take place before the lasagna making begins and will be also be held at Julie's house.

Pizza (Mon 3/25 and Tues 4/1): Doing the one-day-a-week pizza days seems to be working. At the most recent one (4/1), there were only 3 slices left. The staff has suggested doing the next one on Thursday (4/11) instead of Wednesday, as there is already a lot going on this coming Wednesday. We agreed this would work, and that the following week's pizza day will be Wednesday (4/24) instead of Thursday. I hope this makes sense.

Snacks at the Counter (ongoing): yogurt was a hit; Chip expects it to be gone by this Friday. We will be rotating different snacks as their supplies are exhausted. Next week, we will be doing trail mix.

Upcoming Events

Earthday (4/19): all members in attendance (excluding myself because I don't have any onsite classes) having been, and will be, plugging the event in their respective classes. Chips has been doing so as well. We discussed extending the cleanup to the shore, as this would possibly be more rewarding than just working on the parking lot (keeping plastics from getting in the ocean).

Food During Finals week: we discussed possibly doing something besides pizza, since we have been doing weekly pizza days leading up to finals week. Different ideas were mentioned, with a consensus leaning towards protein-rich foods like beef jerky, hard-boiled eggs, etc.

Student Care Packages: Current plans have been shelved for next semester. There was already too much going on to get all the logistics and whatnot underway for the current semester. Fall stuff to be ordered in the upcoming weeks so everything will be ready to go for the fall semester.

Stress-Down Week: still need contracting for this. Chip meeting with Wendi and Allina tomorrow (4/4) to get further details on where we are with this.

Monhegan Trip: we are still deciding on whether or not to get a photographer to be part of this event.

Graduation (): blankets have been ordered for a gift for graduating UROCK students.

SA Elections: signups need to be in by Monday (4/8)

Expressions Night: Chip ordering/picking up food. He gets off work at 4pm that day, so there should be enough time to get it. Food will be in the student lounge room (407).

Possible Future Events

White Water Rafting: if money in budget allows, we proposed doing a white water rafting day. Melissa looked up ticket prices for June 18th (a Tuesday), and they were around \$1342.95 for 15 tickets. With this price range, we suggested a ticket price for students and guests that would cover the \$300+, with the SA paying the \$1000. If we plan on doing a different day, the days in the middle of the week are usually cheaper. We agreed on 15 tickets as this is the max amount of passengers one of our busses can carry, and the boats hold a max of 8 passengers.

Other ideas for unused budget money: rental items, including wifi hotspots, digital cameras, (kids) birthday party supplies. Chip will be talking to the photography instructor about the camera, I'll be checking the wifi.

Future Game Night Dates: Amy to work with Althea about what would be good times/dates.

ASL Night at Rock City: We agreed to funding the purchase of 15 UROCK t-shirts for our students attending this event.

Sanitary Products: We discussed purchasing sanitary products for the ladies' room, and agreed to do a trial to see how it goes (if they go too quickly, it may need to be retooled). Melissa and Amy spoke with the staff and they agreed to let the (female – I would do it but I might get some strange looks) work study students be in charge of restocking.
